




ALMA Director's Discretionary Time (DDT) Overview


- Up to 5% of the observing time per cycle can be awarded through DDT
- DDT review process
 - DDT review committee reviews the proposal
 - committee has 8 members total
 - 2 members each from East Asia, Europe, and North America
 - 1 member each from Chile and JAO
 - Committee's recommendation is sent to the ALMA Director
 - ALMA Director makes decision on whether to accept the proposal
- The following slides show the DDT results from Cycles 1 to 10 in terms of the number of submitted/accepted proposals and requested/approved observing time.



Number of DDT proposals and acceptance rate by cycle ALMA




: Number of submitted and accepted proposals by Cycle Left Right : Acceptance rate of DDT proposals by Cycle










Category 1: Cosmology and the high redshift universe

DDT proposals by science category





Top row: Number of submitted (blue) and accepted (orange) proposals by science category.

Fraction of DDT proposals by region






Top row: Number of submitted (blue) and accepted (orange) proposals by the regional affiliation of the PI.

Bottom row: Acceptance rate by regional affiliation..




DDT observing time: requested and accepted
